5. Expensive	<u>more expensive</u>	<u>most expensive</u>
6. Long	<u>longer</u>	<u>longest</u>
7. Bad	<u>worse</u>	<u>worst</u>
8. Green	<u>greener</u>	<u>greenest</u>
