

Homophones Answer Key

This worksheet reviews the homophones: your/you're, I/eye, see/sea, and (to a lesser extent) its/it's, there/their/they're, here/hear, pair/pear, weak/week, and two/too/to.

Students are to underline the right choices in each sentence.

1. Your/You're staying at their/there/they're house next weak/week.
2. If your/you're eye/I is hurt you won't be able to sea/see well.
3. Conner heard the sea/see was to/too/two cold to swim in, but its/it's not.
4. Let me sea/see what you're/your doing in you're/your drawing class.
5. I/Eye sea/see your/you're to/too/two pairs/pears of socks over hear/here.
