

Simple Subject and Predicate Answer Key

This worksheet reviews knowing where to divide the subject from the predicate in a simple sentence and identifying the simple subject and simple predicate.

In each sentence, students are to draw a line to separate the subject from the predicate then underline the simple subject and the simple predicate.
