Review 1

•	The paper is titled appropriately.
•	Every step of the process is accurately explained.
•	Every step is clearly explained.
•	There is sufficient information provided.
•	The information is organized in a clear manner.
•	There are transitions to provide flow throughout the paper.
Review 2	
•	All capitalization is correct.
•	All punctuation is correct.
•	Any other grammar rules you know are followed correctly.
