Revising an Interview

Most of writing is rewriting. When rewriting a report on an interview, here is a checklist of what to review to improve your rough draft. I have separated these into two groups. Focus on the first group on your first rewrite of the interview, and the second group when you're writing your final draft.



Review 1

•	The paper has a title.
•	The first paragraph introduces the topic.
•	The first paragraph makes the reader interested in the interviewee.
•	The information is well organized.
•	There are transitions throughout the paper.
•	All quotes are formatted and punctuated correctly.
•	The conclusion is interesting (the paper doesn't just stop).
•	The conclusion reflects in some way on the person's story.
Review 2	
•	All capitalization is correct.
•	All punctuation is correct.
•	Any other grammar rules you know are followed correctly.
