# **Rewriting an Essay of Personal Experience**

Most of writing is rewriting. When rewriting your personal essay, here is a checklist of what to review to improve your rough draft. I have separated these into groups. Focus on the first group on your first rewrite of the essay, the second group on the second rewrite, the third group on your third rewriting, and the last group when writing your final draft.



# **Review 1 (Description)**

# Descriptions of people include (need not be all, but strive for at least three):

- Physical appearance
- \_\_\_\_\_ Mannerisms
- How they move
- \_\_\_\_\_ How they speak
- \_\_\_\_\_ Facial expressions
- Personality

Descriptions of places include (need not be all, but strive for at least three):

- \_\_\_\_\_ Sights
- Sounds
- Smells
- \_\_\_\_\_ Touch
- \_\_\_\_\_ Taste
- \_\_\_\_\_ Descriptions of more important people and things are more detailed than important ones.

## Review 2 (Dialogue)

- \_\_\_\_\_ If not already present, look for a good place to include dialogue or monologue.
- \_\_\_\_\_ The dialogue is correctly punctuated.
- \_\_\_\_\_ The dialogue is correctly formatted.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Capitalization in the dialogue is correct.

### **Review 3 (Internal details)**

- \_\_\_\_\_ You include your thoughts about key events.
- \_\_\_\_\_ You include your feelings about key events.
- \_\_\_\_\_ There is a good balance of narration (story-telling), description, dialogue, and reflection.

### **Review 4 (Final draft)**

- \_\_\_\_\_ The paper is titled.
- \_\_\_\_\_ All capitalization is correct.
- All punctuation is correct.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Any other grammar rules you know are followed correctly.
